Re: REACH Regulation

Pax AB is fully aware of the REACH regulation on chemicals and the different Requirements and obligations it involves (as far as expected due to the complexity of the regulation).

The role of Pax AB under REACH is as a downstream user of chemicals and a manufacturer of articles, where Pax assemble components from subcontractors into completed articles. The articles mainly consist of ordinary materials such as steel, electronic goods and plastics.

Pax fulfill its obligations as a downstream user and a manufacturer of articles according to REACH. Pax have no obligation to register any of its present products according to REACH.

Concerning substances of very high concern (SVHC) Pax AB have at present no knowledge that its products or packaging contain any of the SVHC proposed to the candidate list.

Pax has secured that theirs subcontractors are aware of and will attend to their obligations according to REACH.

Pax has the confirmation from its subcontractors that none of the substances on the candidate list are present in Pax products. If it comes to Pax knowledge that its products or packages contain any SVHC, we will inform due parties without any delay.
